### Journal Moves

The ACCP journal, *Chest*, has moved to Elsevier's Science Direct online platform as of January. The full text links in PubMed and Google Scholar to most current *Chest* articles will not work until our third-party journal link manager makes the necessary changes. We hope to have the new links in working order very soon. In the meantime, the new web address (<http://www.sciencedirect.com/science/journal/00123692>) is being added in a note in the e-journal database record for *Chest*.

In addition, the ACC journals such as *Journal of the American College of Cardiology* are moving from the Science Direct platform to Highwire Press later this year. Once the change takes place, we will most likely only have access to the journal mentioned above and not the other ACC journals.

### ACLS and BLS Updates

The training materials for BLS for Healthcare Providers will be available very soon. The CPR/AED and ACLS

materials will be available later. The Library will obtain them as soon as possible when published.

### Writing and Publication Aids

The Publishing Tools web page (<http://library.uthct.edu/publish.htm>) is the source for information on citation formats, copyright, journal title abbreviations, and writing style. It is also accessible by clicking the Web Sites by Topic link on the right side of any Library web page, then clicking Publishing Tools. In addition, the Library has over fifty books on writing and publishing. For a list of the books that includes links to online versions, do a keyword search for *writing* in the WebVoyage online catalog (linked as Library Catalog from the right side of any Library web page).

### NCBI Webinars

The National Library of Medicine has a web page at <http://www.ncbi.nlm.nih.gov/home/coursesandwebinars.shtml> that allows you to see a listing of upcoming webinars on resources of the National Center for Biotechnology Information (NCBI) and register for them.
